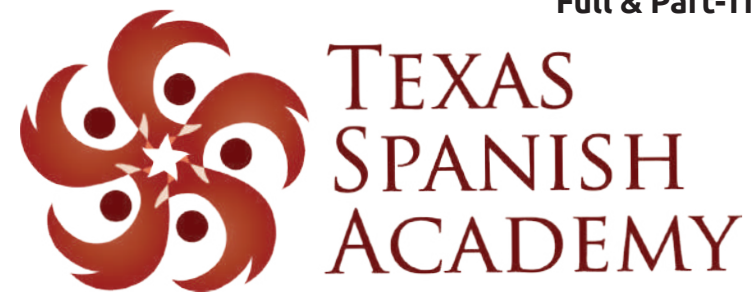

THE KERLEY FAMILY

When I first moved to Round Rock, I thought it unusual to find someone who was born and raised in Round Rock, and are now choosing to raise their own family here as well. For the Kerley Family, there is no other place they would rather be. Not only do they live here, they work hard to make Round Rock a better community.

Amy Kerley grew up attending Round Rock ISD schools. She went to Deep Wood Elementary, was the first class to go thru Hopewell Middle School (with Mrs. Linda Herrington as her principal), and was the second class to go all 4 years through Stony Point High School.

"Round Rock was never one of those towns you couldn't wait to get out of. We're all staying here and raising our families here, because we want our kids to have what we had growing up", says Kerley.

For her, Round Rock will always have a small town feel, yet she was able to see the transformation and growth it has undergone. From attending the first Round Rock Express ballgame when she was in 8th grade to seeing the ground broken for America's Largest Indoor Waterpark, Kalahai Resorts, Amy speaks fondly of 'being along for the ride.'

"I love that Mrs. Herrington was actually my school principal and now there is a school named after her. I love that there is a real connection and personal tie to my town, you can't do that everywhere."

When asked what she missed from her years growing up, she spoke fondly about going to lunch after church to La Margarita, back when it was located in an old train car off I-35. And Lone-

star Bakery has always been a staple in her life. She even tells a story of her younger brother breaking out of Mothers' Day Out at the First Baptist Church to run across the street to get Round Rock Donuts.

After high school, Amy earned her college degree online so she could work with her father's sports construction business. She credits him for what she learned about being a small business owner. And the desire to own her own business was born at an early age.

During this time, she met her husband, Aaron Kerley. Aaron was raised in Hutto and he has his own unique connection to the community. His great, great grandfather was professor Benjamin "Doc" Kerley, who started the Hutto School for the Colored in the early 1900s.

It was after they built a house in Round Rock's Sienna neighborhood, that it was announced the school in their neighborhood would be named Benjamin "Doc" Kerley Elementary School. And now the Kerley's oldest daughter attends there.

Less than 10 years ago, Round Rock experienced a 'Baby Boom', where the town saw a dramatic influx of children being born. The Kerley's were a part of that boom, with the birth of their first daughter, Leighton. At the time, there

was only one locally-owned childrens' clothing store in Round Rock.

In October 2012, Amy and her mother created Haute Tots Boutique and would attend Georgetown Market Days selling designer kids' clothing. It quickly developed a following and they went to even bigger shows across Texas. They had gained so much popularity, they even held shopping lunch hours at her father's construction business office.

In June 2015, it was time to take the business in a new direction. Amy opened a shop in the beautiful yellow house in Downtown - the oldest standing wood structure in Round Rock. She remembers being so disappointed on opening day. Only 2 people showed up.

"We decided to start a Facebook Page. And social media completely changed the game for us," she recalls. She would post photos of her daughter in outfits and thus began the 'shopping online' experience for Haute Tots.

What started as a unique way to advertise to customers quickly grew to a vibrant 7500+ community Facebook group. As the boutique grew, they

began to offer womens' clothing, cups and jewelry.

And while Amy's businesses grew - they added Gingersnaps Boutique on the Georgetown Square in 2018 and Mercantile on Main in Downtown Round Rock in 2019-the Facebook Group remains a constant.

They have successfully created an online space of inclusivity - no matter your size, color, or nationality, this group immimates love and empowerment. It encourages women to be their best self.

And while the 3 boutiques' success is amazing, it's the general sense of love and acceptance of who we are - no matter what we look like - that comes from the Facebook group that I admire most. And in a short 5 years, Amy now owns 3 boutiques and an online business, employing 15.

She gives back to the community as well, offering spirit nights and discounts to school groups. And her Facebook

group has built a sense of community where her customers feel like family. When you see her, she gives you the most loving hug and greets you as if you are the highlight of her day. That's who she is. She genuinely cares about you and loves to see you.

Aaron and Amy love being a part of the Round Rock community. In 2006, Aaron started his select basketball business, Rim Rockers Basketball, to ensure that kids who couldn't afford select sports would have an opportunity to play. It started with one group of seven young men and has grown to 14 teams today.

"This is my hometown and I love the camaraderie. The minute you start a small business, a support system follows with an immediate link to resources. There is a sense of community that people are rooting for you and they don't want to see you fail."

But it's not without hard work. With 2 young daughters, Amy recognizes that time management can be difficult. She wants to be there for all of her employees and clients

and still be able to tuck her daughters into bed at night. It has been a tough lesson to learn that it's "Ok to not do it all." She recognized early on that to be successful, she needed to have a team helping her accomplish all her goals, while still being the mom she wanted to be. Her first priority will always be her family.

The Kerley's make living in Round Rock fun too. Their idea of a great date night is at Jack Allen's Kitchen enjoying pimento cheese, a fried pork chop and black cherry margaritas. They enjoy family nights with pizza from Slapbox Pizzicheria or movies at Flix Brewhouse. A lot of their free time is spent with their girls.

While Amy's story is not unique - a small town girl builds something big in her community - her courage and motivation is. While most people dream about their goals, she didn't. She created something with them.

Her encouragement to others is this, "If you have a dream and you are afraid to take the leap - don't be! You CAN do it all - you can be a mom, you can be an amazing wife, and you can be a great Christian woman-with the right people helping you get there." 🍀

STAY

We checked in to The Ruby Hotel, Round Rock's first and only boutique hotel, located on Brushy Creek. It's name was derived from a love letter found on the property addressed to a "Dearest Ruby" in a pile of leaves and trash. The letter was the brand inspiration for the hotel, and you can see it come to life throughout the property.

Try to grab a room with a patio that backs up to the river and enjoy the beautiful view. Each room is unique with vibrant hues of blue and green as well as pink bathrooms - it has a very 1960's feel. I felt like I was stepping foot onto a scene from Mad Men. Included with your stay is a delicious breakfast buffet and access to their pool with a garden view. You can enjoy appetizers and cocktails at their mid-century Ruby Bar prior to going out for dinner.

EAT

One of our favorite places to dine on date night is Jack Allen's Kitchen. You can't beat the craft cocktails and locally sourced southern-

inspired dishes. Never pass up the red chile fries as an appetizer and save room for dessert. My favorite is the chocolate bomb.

If you enjoy seafood, check out Jack Allen's sister restaurant next door, Salt Traders Coastal Cooking. A casual environment in a seaside inspired setting serving lobster rolls, fish tacos and raw bar selections.

Gino's Italian Restaurant is where I head when I'm craving authentic Italian. It's family-run for 25 years, and has won Best of Round Rock awards for seven years straight! If you are wanting to grab a quick bite, stop downtown at Slapbox Pizzicheria and pick up one of their famous giant slices to-go.

PLAY

If you are up for an outdoor adventure there are numerous trails to explore, including Brushy Creek Trail, which is over 3 miles long. You can catch the sunset and the famous bats from Urban Rooftop, Round Rock's only rooftop bar.

Stick around for live music after the sunset.

Speaking of live music, you don't have to leave the city to find some. We enjoy the live entertainment at Rockey's Piano Bar, Longbranch Saloon, and Alcove Cantina.

If we are looking for a quieter evening, we'll see a movie at Flix Brewhouse and grab frozen yogurt at The Yogurt Experience. For an intellectual challenge, plan for an escape room game at Escapology. Or try out your artistic side with a class at one of the many art studios in town, like Toast & Timber.

Life can get busy, but we all need a break to explore and enjoy the city we live in! I hope you discover all that Round Rock has to offer for a fun staycation. 🌵

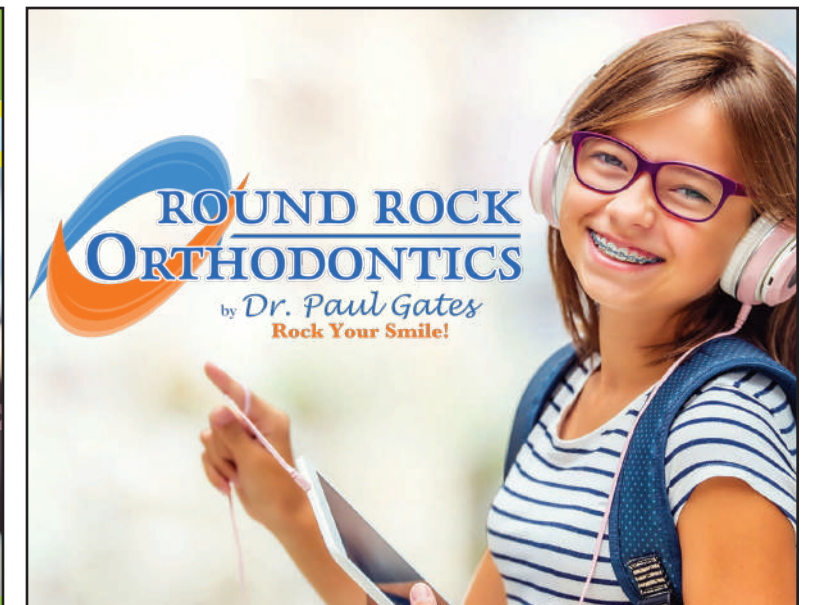

A MONSTER GOOD TIME

In the age of iPhones, Netflix, and competitive club sports, quality family time is becoming harder to come by. Locally-owned Monster Mini Golf and Laser Tag was created for that very reason - for a family to find a unique way to spend time together.

Monster Mini Golf and Laser Tag is an indoor entertainment center in East Round Rock that offers glow-in-the-dark mini golf, a full-scale laser challenge, birthday party rooms, and arcade games. They opened the summer of 2017 and have been busy ever since.

When local owners, Brian and Amy Smith and their two boys moved to Round Rock from Illinois a few years ago they found it lacking a specific family experience that they all enjoyed - miniature golf. Their son is autistic and mini-golf is a perfect ice-breaker for them when they are on vacation or in a new location.

"New is tough on those on the autism spectrum and we could usually find mini-golf whenever we traveled and although each course was different, the game itself was familiar and typically silly. Nate likes to laugh," says Amy.

But when they found themselves in Round Rock, they were disappointed

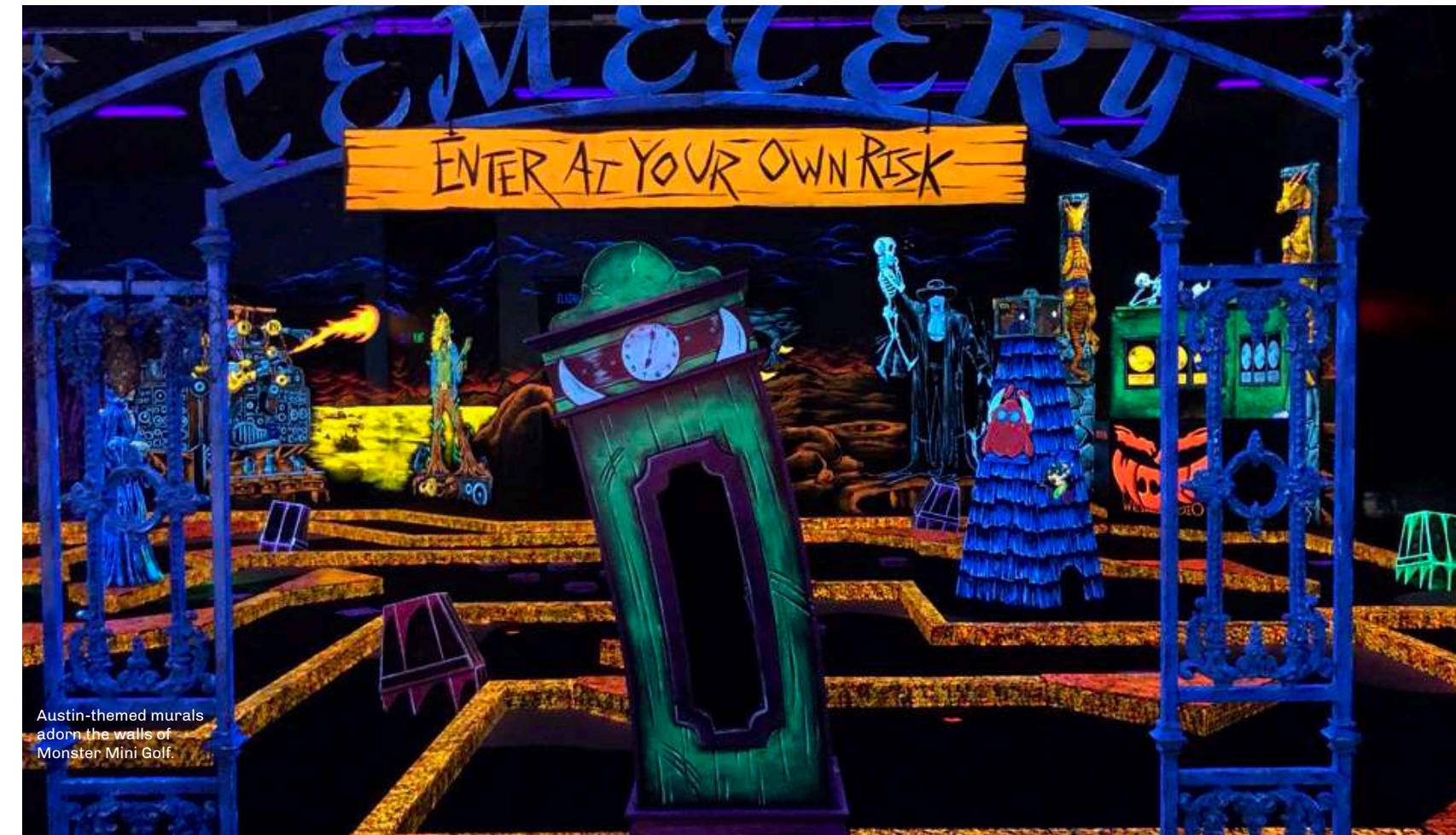
to find only a handful of mini golf spots in Central Texas.

Their disappointment turned into a terrific business opportunity to bring Monster Mini Golf, a nation-wide franchise, to our city. And in a very smart business move, they chose an indoor, glow-in-the-dark mini-golf business, where families can enjoy playing year round - especially in the summer.

The highlight of Monster Mini Golf and Laser Tag is the unique miniature golf course. All 18 holes are indoors, in a darkened room, with the most colorful, glow-in-the-dark murals adorning the walls. The Smiths hired local artists to design the "monsters" taken from well-known Austin spots like the Cathedral of Junk, Matthew McConaughey, and the University of Texas. There is even a "shout-out" to our round rock on their walls.

The course is run by a DJ who periodically calls out challenges for whichever hole you are playing, starts up dance parties and more. The goal is to make every round of golf a new experience for patrons.

Unique to the Round Rock Monster Mini Golf, a 20-person laser challenge is also available (only a few other franchises have laser

tag). Fun for all ages, laser tag is great for big groups of friends or corporate team-building.

The Smiths worked hard to bring unique arcade games to Monster Mini Golf and Laser Tag as well. It's nostalgic for the parents who grew up going to the arcade on the weekends and fun for our kids who are fans of Stranger Things. Monster Mini Golf and Laser Tag also has two party rooms, offering birthday parties throughout the day.

The Round Rock Serving Center

Did you know that we have a food pantry in Round Rock that helps local families? Our guess is that many think an affluent city like Round Rock wouldn't have the need for a food pantry - but they're wrong. And in light of Covid-19, even more families in our community are in need.

Read on to learn about the Round Rock Serving Center and how you can help.

The Round Rock Area Serving Center has helped local families in crisis with their basic needs for 34 years, and they are not letting a virus stop them. "My greatest concern is that families affected by Covid-19 are waiting for us to open to get help," says Executive Director Lori Scott.

In mid-March the Center's store and walk-in food pantry at 1099 E. Main Street in downtown Round Rock closed. So they started a drive-thru. As many as 100 cars wind through the



drive-through on distribution days, translating to a 35% spike in the number of families they are serving.

About 50,000 under-privileged, low-income people and families in crisis benefited from the Center's programs in 2019. Normally, families meet with staff at the Center to fill out paperwork and enter the program.

Clients would then select the food at the on-site food pantry and get clothing at the thrift store. The financial assistance

program helped clients pay partial rent, utilities and prescriptions.

Now applications are taken and interviews are conducted over the phone. And the food is loaded directly into the trunks of vehicles.

"We are already seeing that a third of those we are serving are impacted by Covid-19 - business closures, job losses and layoffs," says Scott. "We are seeing families that haven't had to ask for help before, families that are normally working that are going to need some help to get over this."

Volunteers for food distribution and gardening are needed. But financial contributions are needed more. The closing of the Center's thrift store has been a huge blow, says Scott. The store generates about \$30,000 in revenue per month which is then used to fund the financial assistance program and the food pantry.

"Our immediate need is to keep the food pantry going", says Scott. "So people are bringing food donations, which is great. But the easiest way to help is to make a financial contribution."



Financial donations can be made online at www.rrasc.org. "Everything we purchase from the Central Texas Food Bank costs us about 11 cents a pound," Scott says, "so we can really stretch any financial contribution."

The Serving Center is still closed but they plan to open and resume normal operations and business hours on Monday, June 29.

Drive-through food distribution for those living in zip codes 78664, 78665, 78681, 78634, 78717 and 78728 continues through June 27 on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturdays from 10 a.m. - noon will be added on June 6.

Beginning June 1, a food voucher from the Center will be required to pick up food. Email clflores@rrasc.org to request a voucher. Vouchers will be mailed to families.

Families needing assistance with rent and living expenses through June 27 should apply via phone through by calling the Center at 512-244-2431.

Treasures Resale Shop & Boutique will open and merchandise donations will be accepted beginning June 1. Store hours will be Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. and Saturdays from 9 a.m. to noon. Donation hours will be Monday – Saturday from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.
